



Important: All documents submitted to UEWM as part of the application becomes the property of the university. This is a common practice among schools in the U.S. Students should always request more than two sets of their transcripts for other future needs.

MSTCM Admission Requirements: Applicants must have completed at least two years of baccalaureate-level education, comprising 60 semester units (90 quarter units), at an institution accredited by the U.S. Secretary of Education or at an approved foreign university, or have a bachelor's degree or higher from a recognized institution, in order to qualify for admission to UEWM. A minimum overall grade point average of 2.0 is required.

All documents are required to be in English and submitted within 2 weeks prior to the start of the semester or within 2 weeks of your application, with the exception of the Official Transcript which should be submitted no later than the end of the first semester.

(No later than the end of the first semester)
- Copy of a Proof of Residency (e.g. Passport, Permanent Resident Card etc.)
- Photo (Passport Photo Size)
- Current Resume
- Two Letters of Recommendation (Form available online)
- 500 words Statement of Purpose to study TCM (Form available online)
- Certificate of Bank Statement indicating minimum balance of \$15,000 (**International Student Only**)
- Financial Support Certificate-Form available online or Notarized Form I-134 (**International Student Only**)
- Signed Student Enrollment Agreement
- Official TOEFL score (UEWM Inst. Code: 0256) or Official IELTS score**
*****FEDERAL FINANCIAL AID*****

Students will not be able to request Federal Financial Aid until all required admission documents are submitted.

* Official transcripts must be submitted with the original envelopes in which they were sent. Transcripts from colleges/universities outside of the U.S. must be evaluated for degree, course by course and GPA by a U.S. based official evaluation organization that is NACES Certified. ** For an applicant whose education is not received in the English language, the minimum English requirements (TOEFL iBT or IELTS) :

TOEFL iBT: total score – 61, speaking score –20, listening score – 17

or IELTS: overall band score 6, speaking score –6.5, listening score – 6
